


Al-Maqrīzī's *al-Habar 'an al-bašar*

This volume contains the edition and translation of the chapter of al-Maqrīzī's *al-Habar 'an al-bašar* dealing with Greeks, Romans, Byzantines, Franks, and Goths. This chapter is, for the most part, an almost exact reproduction of Ibn Ḥaldūn's *Kitāb al-Ṭabar*, from which al-Maqrīzī derived material from many other sources, including prominent Christian sources such as *Kitāb Hurūšiyūš*, Ibn al-Amīd's *History*, and works by Muslim historians like Ibn al-Atīr's *Kāmil*. Therefore, this chapter of *al-Habar 'an al-bašar* is a continuation of the previous Arabic historiographical tradition, in which European history is integrated into world history through the combination of Christian and Islamic sources.

MAYTE PENELAS, Ph.D. (1998), Autónoma University, Madrid, is Tenured Scientist and current director of the School of Arabic Studies (EEA), Spanish National Research Council (CSIC). She edited *Kitāb Hurūšiyūš*, and published articles on this text, and on other Arabic texts produced by the Christians of al-Andalus, including those that make up MS Raqqāda 2003/2.
